The Department of Health Policy & Management, Graduate School of Public Health, University of Pittsburgh invites applications and nominations for the position of **Professor** and **Chair** of the Department of Health Policy and Management (HPM).

The Department has strong programs of research and education for health policy and management (see www.hpm.pitt.edu); offers a fully accredited MHA and a MPH with foci in Health Policy Analysis, Public Health Management, or Health Program Management; and will launch a PhD Program in Health Services Research and Policy in Fall 2008. Current faculty strengths include health economics, health policy, health services research, organizational theory/organizational behavior, patient safety and quality of care. Anticipated additions include faculty with strengths in global health and perhaps system science in Public Health.

The Department is located in the Graduate School of Public Health, which includes 152 faculty members who collectively hold more than \$88.7 million dollars in externally funded research grants (see www.publichealth.pitt.edu). In addition, the Department has numerous ties to a very strong academic health center and to relevant research centers throughout the campus. The University of Pittsburgh (see www.pitt.edu) encourages and facilitates collaboration among its faculty and across its centers, departments, and institutes.

Qualifications for the position include a terminal degree, or an equivalent of extensive experience in a discipline, field, or activity related to the Department's and School's research and academic programs. We also seek applicants with strong, visionary leadership capabilities. Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated national and international reputations for excellence in research, scholarship, and education in health policy and management. We seek applicants who are qualified for an appointment as a Full Professor with Tenure. It is also important that applicants have demonstrated records of innovative and dynamic leadership in academic settings and solid administrative skills.
